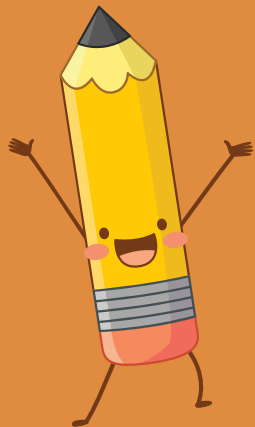

Students chorally read a text in Japanese or go over English words and phrases in a quick and rhythmic pace.



What is 'Root Time'?

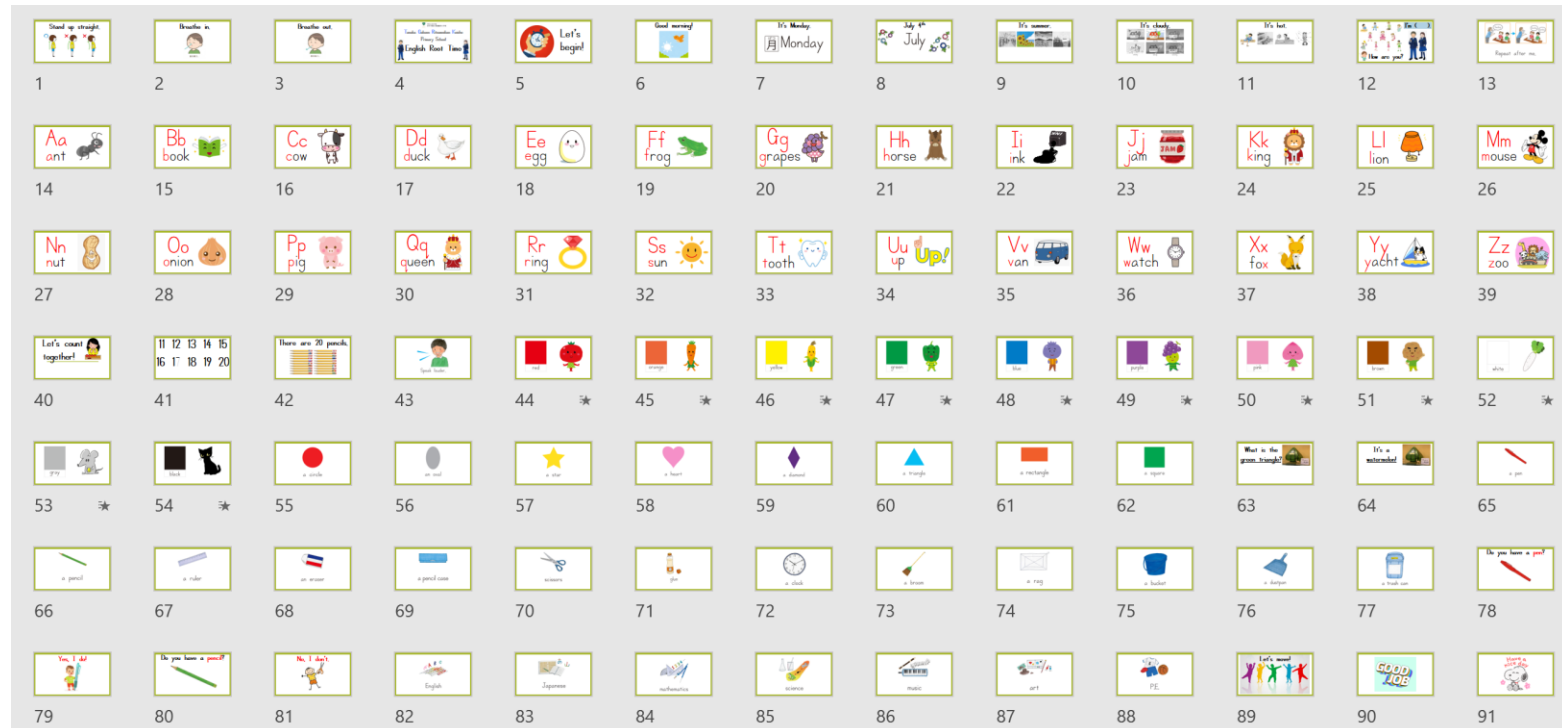


Teachers share and collaborate on their Root Time content via Teams.

Blending Lines

Blending lines are lines of words that students sound out using their phonics knowledge. Blending lines allow students to practice the new focus skill and review previously learned skills.

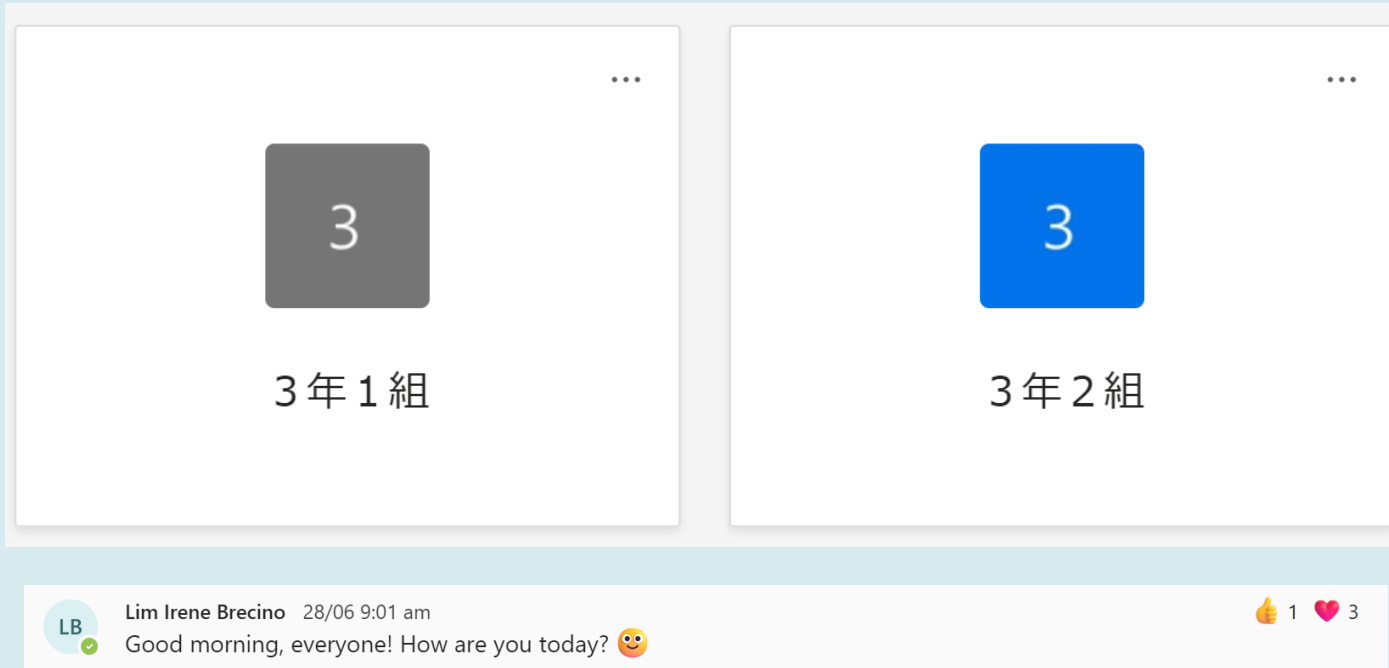
